### **Marking and Feedback Guide**

At The Nar Valley Federation, we believe all children are entitled to regular and comprehensive feedback to support their learning and progress of every child.

Feedback may be given verbally during the course of the learning process. Teachers will provide next steps where appropriate to extend learning or highlight an area which needs further consolidation. Where appropriate opportunities are provided for peer marking and feedback against a given criteria.

#### **Expectations:**

- All work is dated
- There is a learning ticket for each piece of work which includes an objective
- Children and teachers assess work using a traffic light system
- All work is marked daily where possible
- There are high expectations of presentation in all books
- Children respond regularly to marking and have the chance to edit and improve their work
- The marking code is followed by all
