Sept - Dec 2016	Year 1 and 2 swimming lessons at Necton Pool taught by swimming instructor	£1400	Pupils in Y1 gained confidence in the water and benefited from smaller groups than last year. Y2 pupils further developed skills from last year
April – July 2016	KS2 Swimming lessons	£2330	Y3-6 swam weekly for a term with the development of water safety skills as well as swimming skills, especially for those weaker swimmers
Sept 16-March 17	Poolside Training for teachers/TAs	£230 +190 cov	Staff confident to lead groups of pupils in the pool
April 16-March 17	PE Resources – following PE resources audit	£1000	Greater opportunities to develop a range of skills and provide additional challenge for pupils
