Y6 Residential Trip 18th September to 20th September 2019

An exciting opportunity is available for your son or daughter next year. We are pleased to announce that we have booked students a place at **PGL, Caythorpe Court** in the beautiful surroundings of Lincolnshire.

About Caythorpe Court

Caythorpe Court is a fantastic centre based in Lincolnshire. With 65 acres of grounds surrounding a huge mansion house there are loads of great facilities and even more brilliant PGL activities than ever! There is a purpose-built dining room, archery range and on-site lake.

As well as this, the children will have fun-packed evening entertainment programmes for each night of their visit.

The staff are all highly qualified and the centre at Caythorpe Court is safe, secure and first rate. Particularly popular are the dining room and excellent choice of food – much needed after a day of fun packed activities! Pupils benefit hugely from the experience, both educationally and socially as the three schools come together. Trip Information:

The Trip is for **Y6 pupils** and will take place from **Wednesday 18th September to Friday 20th September 2019**. The cost of the visit will be **£255.00** per pupil and includes return travel by coach, full board, accommodation and a full programme of activities. Adults from the Federation will be with the children throughout the trip.

To confirm our booking, an initial non-refundable **deposit of £30 will be required by 16th November 2018**. Payments can be made in full or in instalments for the trip. Three further payments will need to be made: £75 by 14th January, £75 by 30th April and £75 by 12th July. Alternatively, monthly payments can be made of £25 until the cost of the trip is covered.

Residential courses organised by the school are, of course, optional but an invaluable part of the National Curriculum and your child's development. If your child is eligible for Free School Meals, the

school may be able to offer support to parents and families with payments. Please contact the school for specific details. Unfortunately, if we do not get enough interest then the trip will be cancelled.
