Dear Parents/Carers

Thank you so much to those of you who attended our parent briefing about behaviour.

We are pleased to share with you our new and evolving behaviour policy for play time and lunchtimes. This has been written with the children as well as taking into account some of the feedback we have had from parents.

Due to too many incidents of poor behaviour choices at lunchtimes the school council have worked hard with the staff and their classes to agree consequences that are fair and will ultimately result in lunchtimes being a more pleasant experience for everyone.

The lunchtime behaviour policy has already been adapted to suit the younger children and we are continually listening to and responding to feedback. We are delighted that the children have already seen many positive changes including the following:

'There is less fighting in the playground.'

'The dinner hall is much quieter'

'Having time to think and talk about our behaviour allows us time to feel calm and we know what we would do differently next time'

'Children that were making poor choices are now making good choices'

'I feel proud that our table got chosen to go on the special table'.

'We know and understand what our consequences are going to be'.

An area the children are still concerned about is that some children do not really care about writing a sorry letter. We are looking to use our PATHS feeling cards and build in opportunities for children to talk to one another to try and resolve incidents involving more than one child.
