<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Not playing fairly	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 5 minute reflection to decide what needs to change
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Misuse of equipment	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Warning• Alternative activity offered.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Being disrespectful Telling tales to get others into trouble 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 10 minutes reflection time Verbal or written letter of apology
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Name calling / unkind words 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 10 minutes reflection time Verbal or written letter of apology
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Not being honest / accepting responsibility 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Extra 5 minute reflection time added on

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Swearing 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 15 minute reflection • Verbal or written letter of apology • Blue form • Parents informed
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Retaliating 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Consequence to match poor choice e.g. physical harm, name calling
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Damaging property 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 15 minute reflection time • Blue form • Parents informed

KS2 Consequences

Behaviour	Consequence
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ganging up (in games)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 10 minute detention to write sorry letter
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Not playing fairly	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 5 minute detention to write sorry letter• Banned from game for 3 days
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Misuse of equipment	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 5 minute detention• Moved away from game / equipment for remainder of lunch.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Pulling faces	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Verbal warning
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Not running lunchtime club (Y5/6 only)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 15 minute lunchtime detention following day• Letter of apology

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rough play 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 15 minute lunchtime detention
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Being disrespectful • Back-chatting • Spreading rumours • Winding others up to cause argument / harm • Telling tales to get others into trouble • Damaging property 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 15 minute lunchtime detention • Writing letter of apology
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not being honest / accepting responsibility 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Double consequence for offence committed. • If you own up, extra time is halved.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Climbing trees 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 10 minute detention • Write reasons why it's unsafe
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Disrespecting club leaders 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Warning given • 10 minute detention to write letter of apology • 2 week ban from club

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Threatening Ganging up Swearing / name calling 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 15 minute lunchtime detention Writing letter of apology Blue form Parents informed
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Retaliating 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Consequence to match offence e.g. physical harm, name calling
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Trying to 'escape' from school 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 2 days of lunchtime and playtime detention Writing why it is unsafe Blue form Parents informed
