You may like to write some number sentences for your child to complete ie

5 + 3 =

2 + 7 =

3 + 3 + 3 =

Can your child find things around the house that they can use to count? If they are unsure of how to write the numbers they can refer to a number line. You may need to write a simple one out for them.
