Phonics - revise	Mr Mc Day 7 'oi' words https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ELuONu3buwg
Teach:	'are' (tricky word) Can your child think of some sentences with 'are' in? Can they highlight or circle are in the following sentences? There are four cows in the field. Where are the carrots? Are there 7 days in a week? What are toads?
Reading:	On the computer if possible - Teach your monster to read Any books at home - read together see how many words on a page they can have a go at reading themselves.
Writing:	Follow up from Mr Mc - sentence is Put the coin into the brown pot. Can they make any changes at the end and write one more sentence? For example, Put the coin into the green till.

You may like to make some ramps to see if this helps the veggies to roll further? Vocabulary: distance, how far, furthest and time related vocabulary

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Topic:	The World around us!
	<p><u>My Garden</u> What is growing in your garden? Today I would like you to think about trees. Do you have any trees? Where are they? Did your family plant them? Are the trees all the same? Are they the same size? Do they have any blossom on? What colour are the leaves? What colour is the blossom? Do you know the names of any trees? Can you find any of the trees on the Tree Identification Sheet? If you wanted to measure how round the trunk is - what could you use?</p> <p>If you have some paper and crayons you could make some bark rubbings. Tell your grown up which part of the tree is the bark. How does it feel? What does it look like? Can you look closely at the leaves? You may be able to do some leaf rubbings.</p> <p>Challenge: If you are able to go outside for your daily walk/bike ride - can you look for different trees? Are they the same or different to those in your garden? Can you collect anything that may have dropped from the trees i.e. pine cones?</p>
