

The World around us! Topic: I wonder how you got on yesterday? Did you hear or see any birds? Have you started to fill in your bar chart? Today I would like you to look at the picture below and talk about what you see to a grown up. Please let your child talk first - they may decide to make a story up about what is happening. If they need some help with prompts, some questions you could ask are: What is happening in the picture? Why are the birds carrying the tree? Where did the tree come from? Where are the birds taking the tree? How long will it take? Will they stop on the way? What will happen when they get there? Why might a tree need moving? What are the birds using to hold the tree? Why did the artist use these colours?
