Questions 1, 4 and 7 (Varied Fluency)

Developing Replace the underlined verbs in 2 sentences with alternative verbs. Sentences include mainly CVC/CVCC words.

Expected Replace the verbs in 3 sentences with alternative verbs. Sentences include mainly High Frequency Words and phonetically decodable words.

Greater Depth Replace the verbs in 3 sentences with alternative verbs. Sentences include compound nouns and some words which are not easily decodable.

Questions 2, 5 and 8 (Varied Fluency)

Developing Complete 2 sentences by adding appropriate nouns. Sentences include mainly CVC/CVCC words.

Expected Complete 3 sentences by adding appropriate nouns. Sentences include mainly High Frequency Words and phonetically decodable words.

Greater Depth Complete 3 sentences by adding appropriate nouns. Sentences include compound nouns and some words which are not easily decodable.

Questions 3, 6 and 9 (Application and Reasoning)

Developing Construct three sentences using a word bank. Each sentence to include two nouns and a verb. Word bank includes mainly CVC/CVCC words.

Expected Construct three sentences using a word bank. Each sentence to include two nouns and a verb. Word bank includes mainly High Frequency Words and phonetically decodable words.

Greater Depth Construct three sentences using a word bank. Each sentence to include two nouns and a verb. Word bank includes compound nouns and some words which are not easily decodable.
