



Maths (20 minutes)

Today we are learning about composition of numbers to 5 (3 groups).



Can you draw somewhere for the frogs to play?

You might draw a pond, a log and some grass like me.

Or you could draw a train with 3 carriages, a park or a jungle.

There are 5 frogs altogether but how many frogs can you spot in each group?

You could always draw the frogs and cut them out.

Literacy (15-20 minutes)

Lost and Found Topic

Task:

To begin writing your journey in your postcard. Write 1 sentence about what happened, pretending you are the boy. Tomorrow you will write another sentence to finish off the postcard.

Example of today's writing:

To Mum and Dad

I went on a boat to the South Pole with a penguin.

Grown -ups

Encourage your child to use their sound mats and write the sounds they hear even if it is only the first sound, this is fine. It is completely normal for some children to need to be guided on how to write a letter too. We do air writing with our magic index finger before they try and write their own. Children are at the beginning of their sentence writing journey so will need lots of talk about using a capital letter at the beginning, finger spaces and full stop.



Remember to say your sentence first, use finger spaces, full stops and capital letters and read your sentence back to make sure it makes sense.

Art (30 minutes)

Giant Project

Use this time today to get creating your giant, see if you can include some moving parts such as the joints! Refer to your design and get making!

Afterwards:

Reflect on your giant project and answer these evaluation questions below by drawing and labelling or writing your answers:

- 1) What do you like most about your giant?
- 2) What would you improve or change if you were to make it again?
