



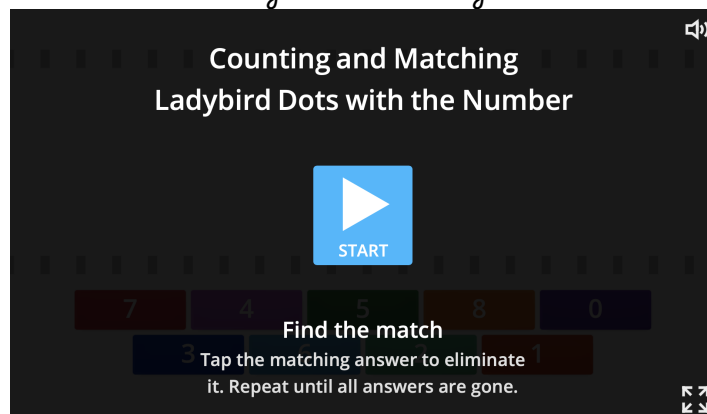
Count some toys into your toy box.

What happens to the number of toys when you take one out and then put it back? Does it matter which toy you remove?



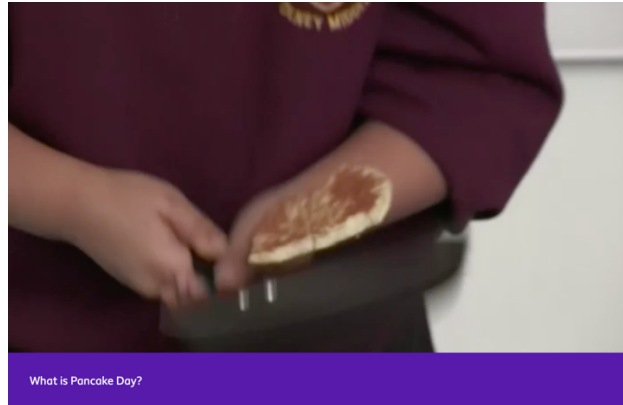
Now play this game! Count how many ladybird dots you can see and then match it to the correct number by clicking on the number.

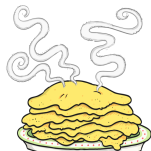

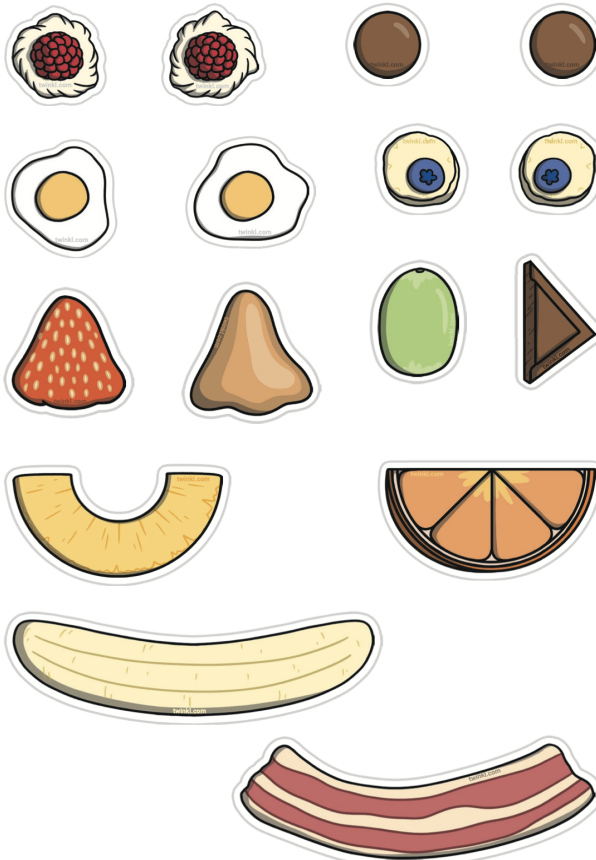
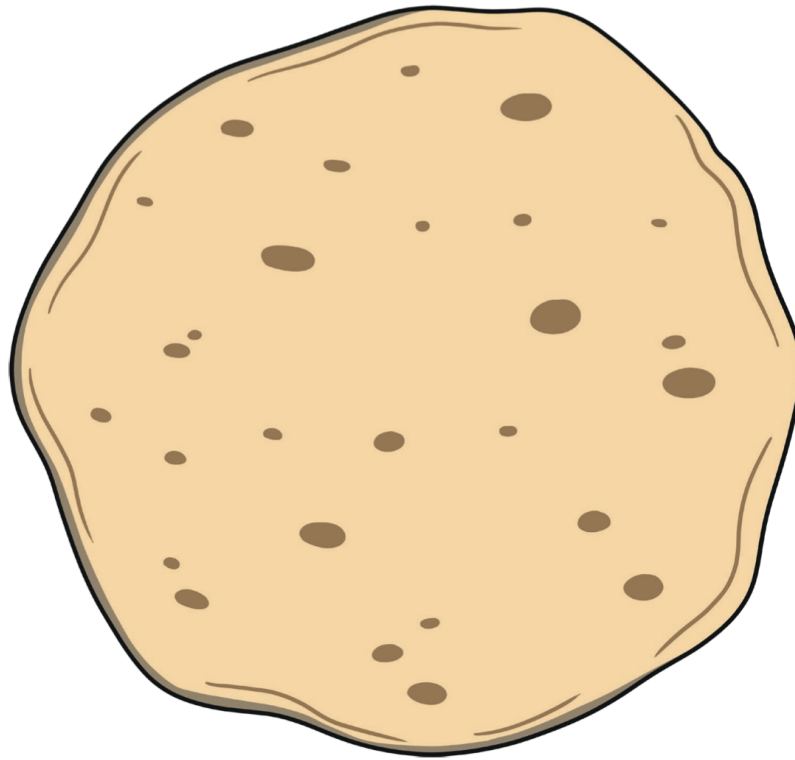
You could always have a go at making a
