

Task: If you do not have dice, you could use your number flashcards up to 10 - turn them upside down and select at random.

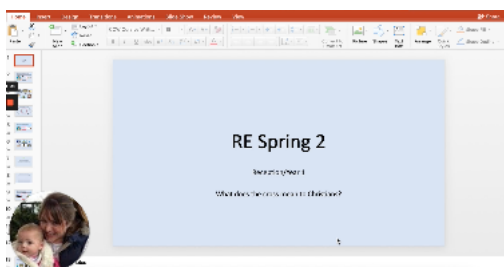

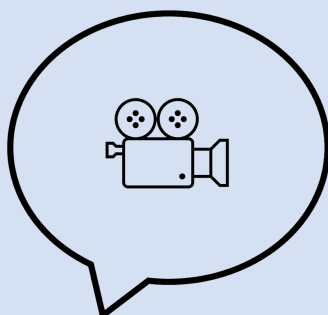
