Marking and feedback approach that is:

- Marking / feedback within the moment
- Enables children to act and improve or correct work as quickly as possible, if not immediately
- Encourage children to develop independent strategies for improvement
- Provide swift concise and high impact feedback our children can act upon
- Work in books should evidence clearly where adult intervention, feedback or support has been given as work will reflect changes with green pen from pupils additions and editing

Non-negotiables:

Every time we write in KS1, KS2 and do maths (posters for children)

In addition to this:

- Learning objectives will be displayed for the learning session in the classroom and referred to in the sequence of learning
- The choice and challenge curriculum will offer three levels of challenge

Marking:

- This will be purposeful and relevant to the child, age, ability and need it will NOT be overly
 detailed
- Marking needs to match need and to move learning on
- Marking will be ongoing in a lesson it will consist of Yellow means Yeah and Pink means Think

Yellow means Yeah!

Highlighted yellow means LO has been met, a target has been met, progress has been made, in Y4,5,6 a yellow dot with a possible written comment relating to positive areas of achievement

Pink means Think

Highlighted in pink indicates where the LO has not been met or an error has been made, a comment may also be added. In Y4,5,6 a pink dot with a possible written comment relating to areas for development or errors

Purple Pens = Adult comments

Green Pens = Pupils editing and improvements

Pink Pens = Peer marking

Feedback and marking will be kept up to date. Feedback in the moment will be completed by teachers, supply cover, HLTAs and teaching assistants.
